

Operations During COVID 19

The COVID 19 pandemic has forced many changes to club operations. We are doing our best to stay open and offer a safe and enjoyable golfing experience for everyone.

Because COVID 19 has caused the clubhouse to close regular food and beverage activity, our revenue has decreased, and our capital improvement demands remain unaddressed. The club presently has only one paid employee, with all our other needs being provided by volunteers.

We operate on the honor system. When the weather is appropriate, carts will be put out for use by players.

Monday-Thursday	\$20 per person
Friday-Sunday	\$30 per person

Players are expected to pay with cash, placed into an envelope with the **date**, **cart number** and **player's name** written on the envelope. The envelope is to be placed in the slot in the workshop door adjacent to the clubhouse. We monitor these payments and you will be confronted if you are playing and have not paid.

We provide free golf to the high school golf teams of both Nicholas County and Webster County. Golf team members are expected to walk the course and are forbidden from using golf carts.
